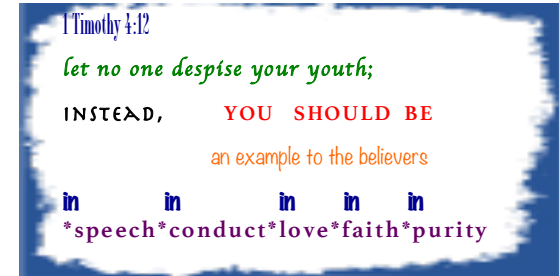

Utter- to say

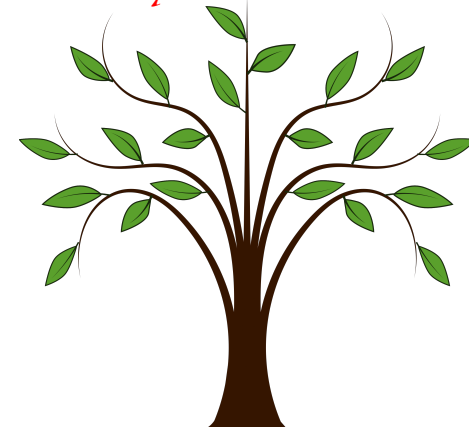
