Practicing It Together:

4. Past experiences of God's faithfulness ought to encourage us to look ahead with trust in the Lord. How does the account in Joshua instruct us in how we practice "remembering" together as a body of believers?

5. Take time right now as a group to "remember" the faithfulness of God together, whether focusing on what He's revealed through His Word or looking at the experiences He's brought you through. Praise Him for His faithful deliverance, and pray that He would continue to develop your own belief and trust in Him as a result.
