1. The Wilderness Generation, vs. 1-5

- “All” were privileged
 - Exodus 13:21 ...pillar of cloud to lead them
 - Exodus 14:21 ...into the midst of the sea
 - Exodus 16:35 ...people of Israel ate the manna
 - Exodus 17:6 ...and the people will drink

- “...the Rock was Christ.”

- Almost “All” were overthrown (Numbers 14:26-38)
