Paul recognizes that he has been allowed to go as far as the Lord would take him. Sometimes we want to do things or go places that we believe will be full of purpose only to be disappointed. What is the territory God has given you, and how are you serving Him there? What other territory are you asking God for, and how will you boast in the Lord once you are there?
